4. Plaintiffs' reply to the Opposition is currently due on September 21, 2016. Plaintiffs request an enlargement of time to file their reply to and including October 12, 2016, to coincide with the deadline previously set by the Court for Plaintiffs to file their Reply to Defendant's Response in Opposition to the Motion to Remand.

5. This motion is made in good faith and not for the purpose of delay. Neither FHFA nor Defendant will be prejudiced by the requested extension.

6. Rule 6(b), Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, vests the Court with the discretion to enlarge for good cause. Based on the foregoing, cause exists to justify the exercise of this Court's discretion to grant this unopposed motion.

Pursuant to Rule 7.1(a)(3), counsel for Plaintiffs conferred with counsel for FHFA and counsel for Defendant, who do not oppose the relief requested in the motion.
