NOTICE TO THE COURT OF RESTORATION OF APPROPRIATIONS

On January 24, 2019, Defendant, the United States Department of the Treasury ("Treasury"), moved for a stay of proceedings – including the Defendants' February 8, 2019 deadline to file replies in support of their motions to dismiss and oppositions to Plaintiffs' motion for summary judgment – in the above-captioned case. *See* ECF No. 24. The Court has not yet ruled on that motion. As of January 25, 2019, after a 35-day lapse, funding was restored for the Departments of Justice and Treasury through February 15, 2019, and the Department of Justice has now resumed its usual civil litigation functions. Undersigned counsel for Treasury requests the opportunity to meet and confer with Plaintiffs' counsel and counsel for the co-Defendants for the purpose of submitting to the Court a proposed briefing schedule that takes into account the duration of the lapse in appropriations no later than Friday, February 1.
