On June 24, 2021, this Court directed the parties to file supplemental letter briefs addressing how this case should proceed on remand following the Supreme Court's decision in *Collins v. Yellen*, 141 S. Ct. 1761, 2021 WL 2557067 (S. Ct. June 23, 2021).
