ORDER


The parties filed a joint status report proposing a briefing schedule for the motions to dismiss Defendants intend to file. (Doc. 81.) The Court **ADOPTS** the parties' proposal. It is therefore **ORDERED** that the following deadlines will govern the anticipated motions to dismiss:

- July 18, 2022: Defendants file their motions to dismiss the Amended Complaint.
- August 15, 2022: Plaintiffs respond to the motions to dismiss.
- September 9, 2022: Defendants file their reply briefs in support of the motions to dismiss.

In the event the Court denies any motions to dismiss, the parties must file a proposed scheduling order within 21 days of the Court's ruling.
