ORDER

On June 21, 2022, plaintiff filed a “Joint Status Report,” and entered the filing on the docket as a “Joint Preliminary Status Report.” The court strikes the filing for the following reasons.

First, this case is stayed until Fairholme Funds, Inc. v. United States, 26 F.4th 1274 (Fed. Cir. 2022), is final and unappealable. See Order of March 24, 2022. Second, until Fairholme Funds is final and unappealable, no filings other than a notice of voluntary dismissal under RCFC 41(a)(1)(A)(i) are permitted in this case. See Order of April 19, 2022. Because Fairholme Funds will not be final and unappealable until at least July 22, 2022, plaintiff’s filing is barred by the orders entered in this case.

Accordingly, the Clerk is directed to **STRIKE** plaintiff’s “Joint Status Report,” filed June 21, 2022.
